What is it all about?


Firstly to have fun! There's nothing better than enjoying music, drink, good food, great company and hopefully sunshine.

However, all proceeds from the festival will go towards raising money for replacing the children's play equipment in Peasemore which is now over 10 years old and has been partially condemned due to the equipment deteriorating and changes of health and safety requirements.



Due to modern regulations around Health and Safety the equipment and installation is not cheap. The project will cost in the region of £25,000 to complete. Although we hope to manage to find some local funding through grants and similar we still believe we will need to find in excess of £13,000 to allow us to complete the project.

The above gives you an idea of what we'd like to achieve for youngsters to enjoy for many years to come.

A festival wouldn't be a festival without having a headband. We are selling these in the activity marquee - so come along and choose your favourite look! Located in the small activity marquee.




Relaxation Zone

Richard Cox-Smith

We're very lucky to have Richard to open the music for us at Peasefest 2018. **Richard Cox-Smith** is a gifted exponent of many styles of guitar playing. First introduced to the instrument by his sister and greatly influenced by her folk orientated record collection he was, like many of his age, first inspired by Bob Dylan. As his playing grew more sophisticated the likes of Bert Jansch and John Renbourn became his roll models, but it wasn't until later that he developed the styles you hear today, following in the footsteps of Michael Chapman and John James. He is now a superbly

talented player of blues, jazz and ragtime (without forgetting his folk roots), and over the years has enjoyed considerable exposure to the public eye, including spots on national TV and radio and touring with Richard Digance, Maddy Prior and Richard Thompson among others.



Lisa Faye

Lisa Faye Broadhead (LRAM, Dip.RAM, ALCM) is a singer, singing teacher, the author of 'Practice or Talent? What makes us musical?' and Director of 5678 Music Entertainment: a company that educates, entertains and enlightens. A graduate of The Royal Academy of Music in Musical Theatre, she has worked in theatre, TV, cabaret, and recordings. Her show 'Streisand – The Main Event' toured the UK after a west end debut. She has worked

with Jim Davidson, The Commitments, The Barron Knights, Jane McDonald, amongst others. Lisa will be performing some of her popular and well known "Diva" repertoire this afternoon - expect to join in!



The Blue Jayzz

The Blue Jayzz will be performing an eclectic range of American Folk and Blues from both the US and UK, on a range of instruments including guitar, harmonica, dobro, banjo, ukulele and mandolin. Doyne and Tim will be known to some in Peasemore as two of the "Three Mad Professors" who performed at St Barnabas in 2017 - their cvs are nothing but impressive -

but today academia gives way to the blues! **Tim Palmer** CBE FRS is a mathematical physicist. **J. Doyne Farmer** is an American complex systems scientist and entrepreneur with interests in chaos theory, complexity and econophysics. Other than that they play some mean blues...!



The Parsons

Performing as a duo for for only a short time the Parsons have performed Fairytale of New York for Swindon Christmas Lights Switch on, supported Mark Chadwick from The Levellers and recorded a new album . They have tallied up dozens of Tequila, Gin, Cider, Beer and Ale Festivals (including Newbury Real Ale Festival). The Parsons are made up of established


musicians **Jimmy Moore** and **Jenny Bracey** who both set out their own solo careers racking up over 2000 live performances, recorded 3 albums, performed all over the South West of England. Abroad in countries such as Nashville, Malta, Italy. As a duo The Parsons were invited to perform alongside Firkin for their 8th Birthday in their home town of Budapest in Hungary. They have supported legends such as Jon Gomm, Danny Bryant, Dave Allman, Aaron Keylock Band, Gaz Brookfield and loads more. Their sing-along mix of Irish (and other regions) folk songs will definitely get you singin' and dancin'!



Tomorrow Bird

Tomorrow Bird is an acoustic folk-duo hailing from Reading, UK. This musical pairing of Jen Bird and Simon Driscoll gives rise to a stunning live act that leaves audiences transfixed. They sing of hope, love, loss, courage and empowerment - creating stories and melodies rendered all the more poignant for the duo's rich vocals and seamless harmonies. Following the release of their debut single, Tomorrow Bird were named

Best Duo at the 2017 GSMC Awards. The pair have also co-written and produced two full length musicals together; The Island of Lost Children and The Best Murder Mystery Party Ever... Jen Bird A former theatre actress, Jen performed lead roles in 'Jesus Christ Superstar' and 'The King & I' before being bitten by the song-writing bug. As a solo artist, she has released two albums and multiple singles. Simon Driscoll - began his musical journey as a classical pianist before becoming the front man of folk-rock band, Burnt Tomorrow. Following the release of the band's first two albums, he returned to his classical roots with the stunning piano album, Hope Shines Through.



Pinot Grigio/Garganega 2016 (Colli Vincentini) - Italy Wine Style: Soft Fruity White

This is proper Pinot Grigio from the Veneto region of North Eastern Italy, blended with a judicious amount of the delicious, lemony Garganega grape. Ripe and scented, this has beautiful balance and texture with or without food. It doesn't get much better than this!



Sauvignon Blanc 2017 (Southern Lights) – New Zealand Wine Style: Aromatic White

Refreshing Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with vibrant, fruity flavours of gooseberry, passion fruit and a hint of grassiness. The palate is full, rich, yet fresh and overall the wine is medium-dry, with a crisp finish. A good quality NZ Sauvignon.



Semillon/Chardonnay 2016 (Home Farm) – Australia Wine Style: Soft Fruity White

Made with Bob Berton's customary attention to detail in New South Wales, this is a great Oz white with the Semillon adding nice freshness to the blend. Easy drinking, soft and with a nice citrus twang to the end of the palate.

Fantastic value Prosecco from our friends at Colli Vicentini, who are one of the few producers to use original grape must in their Prosecco production methods rather than the addition of sugar. Good Prosecco, like this one, must be fresh and gulpable and not left with residual sugar to mask poor quality grapes. Beautifully balanced, with a soft, grapey freshness on the palate - very drinkable!

Malbec Merlot 2017 (Finca del Alta) – Argentina

Wine Style: Fresh Spicy Red


